Look at the materials you have before you put on new shingles. A lot of leaks come from installation, due to nails that aren't the proper size, or shingles that are cracked. The shingles should be strong and crack free, and the nails should be sturdy.

Ask your roofer about warranties on his work. Compare this when choosing a contractor. Also, make sure to get any warranties and estimates in writing, so you will have them in your possession. This way there won't be a disagreement later on.

If you need to get a brand new roof and want to watch out for the environment, try looking into getting a living roof. This type of roof has soil that can grow vegetation. You can only do this on flat roofs, but it's great insulation.

Pay attention to the details as you hire roofing contractors. Someone that's on time to appointments or calls when they tell you is most likely dependable. Also, written quotes and estimates are good signs of professional conduct. You want your chosen roofer to possess both of these important qualities.
